He has taken to his new role with such passion and vigor from him taking the referees course and then to take the new referees out on the weekend to run his line. Once they had enough experience he would run their line for them so they had all the confidence in the world to take on the role we all love but not many people appreciate as being an official. Because of the hard work he put in he was a deserved winner this year of the Bill Grono award. Well done David and we look forward to you taking on the same role in 2008 as we already have 7 potential officials.

We also like to thank Doug Keen and Tony Danks for the effort that they are putting into the local schools to recruit new referees. We appreciate your support and we look forward to working with you in season 2008. Not only did they assist with the recruitment drive at schools this year but were also instrumental in setting up with Robert Finch a buddy system with an NRL official being involved with a local Association. We were lucky enough to have Bernard Sutton as our representative and were able to see him make his debut as a sideline official as well as then going on to referee his first NRL game.

Congratulations Bernard on behalf of our members and thank you for coming to one of our meetings and also a training session to impart your knowledge and skill onto our members. All the best for next season.

It was also very pleasing to see Steve Chiddy and Darryn Lang rejoin the Association. They both went on to have very good seasons. Darryn started the season by being selected into the NRL squad and he trained hard and enjoyed the challenge ahead of him. Langy ended up doing 14 NRL games this season and was always pushing everyone on the training paddock to reach higher levels during each session. Steve Chiddy has so much experience and knowledge of the game. He has refereed in the NRL and has achieved milestones that we can only dream of. He went on and completed 200 games as a Touch Judge (sideline official these days), which means he joins a select few in the 200 club. He also officiated in State of Origin 2 and 3 as well as capping off the year as the Grand Final Touch Judge. Well done Chidds in the great season you had, I look forward to you imparting your skills and knowledge onto our official's in season 2008.

Ron Dean one of our esteemed life members achieved a rare milestone this year as he was awarded the Order of Australia Medal (OAM) for his services to rugby league in the Manly Warringah District. Well done Ron - this is a fantastic achievement; to be able to receive a Life Membership in any Association is a great honor and then to be able to receive and OAM is an unbelievable achievement.

On a sadder note we had the passing of one of our Life Member's Alf Martin, he was a good friend of our life member Barry Cross and he was instrumental in Manly getting into the competition as he played in Manly's President cup winning team in 1946. Our thoughts are with the Martin Family.

Our crop of Junior Development referees this year was depleted dramatically to an all time low. When you say and hear this, it would bring a big question mark and concern over the Association for referee development. However, there is a good reason behind this. We had a record number of our referees graded in one season with Jayson Elkins, Greg Kidd and Danielle Berry doing the Association proud. This was achieved with Greg Kidd (also congratulations to Greg and Sandra on the birth of another son Jonathan) and Danielle Berry being graded at the start of the season as sideline officials and Jayson Elkins having the carrot dangled in front of him to show them what he has got and go out there and achieve his goal of being graded. He took this challenge with the absolute professionalism needed and refereed S G Ball for the whole Junior Development season competition and ended up securing the Harold Matthews Cup Grand Final game at St Mary's between Canterbury and Penrith. This was a cracker of a game going into extra time on a hot 'summery' day in May and Jayson refereed to the best of his ability and had a blinder. All the hard work in training and learning the rules and dedication paid off on this day with a band of mates joining him out at St Marys to see him referee the house down. He was supported on the line by one of his best mates and our Director of Referees Shane Charman. Shane had a great game by always being in the right spot at the right time to assist Elko. Shane performed so well that he was actually offered to be graded as a sideline official but he let this opportunity pass at the moment so he can crack it as a referee. I wish you all the best this season to fulfill your true potential. And one last motivational speech mate: just remember the cream always rises to the top. This is a great time to be a young up and coming referee, as there are so many more opportunities available than I ever dreamed of.

Their success was contributed to in no small way by the dedication from the band of Advisory Board members who voluntarily gave up their time to provide valuable advice and assistance throughout the year and to those members, many thanks for your commitment. On the strength of performances from some of our younger brigade, combined with the continued support of senior referees, I'm sure our membership of the Junior Development Squad will grow in coming seasons. With the likes of Bevan Bourke, Laurie Lawira, Todd Smith, Garry Greco, Luke Eisenhauer, Blake Gillmer and the more senior members such as Matt Noyen and Shane Charman pushing for spots in grade and taking the lead from the most recent graded members of our Association.

It would be remiss of me not to highlight the achievement by Danielle Berry being graded as a sideline official member of the NSWRLRA. Danielle is now the 3rd lady to have been graded to the NSWRLRA and is the first lady from our Association to achieve this high acknowledgement.

It must be remembered however, that nothing is handed to you on a silver platter; it requires hard work and dedication early training sessions by yourself or with your mates but it is all worth it running out on game day and feeling the buzz of the crowd. Well done Danielle.

This year was different from the past 5 years as David Lombardo was not active and competing for the A Grade Grand Final. David was to hand over the mantle this year with numerous members

putting their hand up early to fill this big void. There were strong contenders from Chris Bignold, Shane Charman, and Luke Eisenhauer. However the eventual A grade referee and congratulations go to Matt Noyen on being apportioned his first A grade Grand Final and was a worthy recipient of the Jim Campbell trophy. This is a fine achievement, which was truly deserved after winning the AAMI Encouragement Award in season 2006.

Garry Greco received the AAMI Encouragement Award for his first full season refereeing Sunday and doing A Grade lines. Congratulations for a fine season and we look forward to you getting into the Development Squad and seeing you reach your full potential as a referee.

The Clive Rogers Award for the Best Junior Referee was won by Todd Smith which was really no surprise to anyone, as Todd is a young referee with loads of potential. With the right coaching and some application and dedication on the training paddock he is certainly a referee for the future. Also he has achieved something early on in his referee's career that a lot of us will never get the opportunity to do and that is referee at Telstra Stadium in front of a full house during half time of a State of Origin game.

I'm sure I speak on behalf of all members when I express the sincere appreciation to our major sponsors AAMI and Harbord Bowling Club for their continued support of the Association. Their assistance enabled the Association to help continue the further development of it current members and recruit new members to the Association.

Season 2007 has been a very steep learning curve taking over the role of President and leading our Association in the 75th year.
